Development of new generation furniture and manufacturing technologies by ASS Berendezési Rendszerek Ipari Bt.

ASS BERENDEZÉSI RENDSZEREK Ipari Betéti Társaság of Mako has received 294,5M HUF as non-refundable aid under the tender "Supporting complex technological innovation" of New Széchenyi Plan. With a total budget of 607,3M HUF, the company carries out a development of manufacturing technologies and new generation furniture sets for educational and medical institutions as well as the armed forces for several EU markets.

During 20 years of their operation, ASS Bt. has become the largest manufacturer of school furniture and medical beds in Hungary, besides becoming a NATO supplier more than a decade ago. Furniture sets produced in Mako have served the accommodation of an international staff in Afghanistan successfully.

By implementing this project the company aims to introduce the newest industry technologies, which will also help ASS to achieve new perspectives in product design. This will enable the company to renew their product portfolio and increase their effectiveness while taking into account the aspects of sustainable development.

The procurement for assets include purchasing a sheet and tube laser machine, several robot systems, a hot-air edge finishing aggregate, a powder coating booth with shape recognition feature, besides the most sophisticated tube benders and moulds for injection moulding equipment.

In close co-operation with their Finnish partners ASS are developing a medical bed, while with their German and Austrian customers ASS are expanding their existing product assortment of school furniture, army furniture and shop fittings.

The project is expected to help ASS preserve their competitiveness in international markets, increase the number of their employees already exceeding 300 workers, and strengthening their presence in the Hungarian market.
